



ALA CARTE PURCHASES

Dear Parents,

The food service department for USD 207 does allow for the purchase of extra (A la Carte) items during breakfast and lunch.

We do have the capability to prevent your children (child) from purchasing these items. Please notify your school cafeteria manager or cashier.

- Kindergarten is very restricted and only allowed to purchase extra milk @ \$0.55, yogurt, string cheese, or water @ \$0.75 per item, the daily breakfast item and Ice cream for “Ice Cream Fridays”

1st – 9th grades are allowed to purchase the following items:

We provide these items using the nutritional standards that are required by the USDA, all items including desserts and entrees are whole grain, low sodium while considering students preferences. We will stop ala carte purchases if the balance of the account becomes negative.
